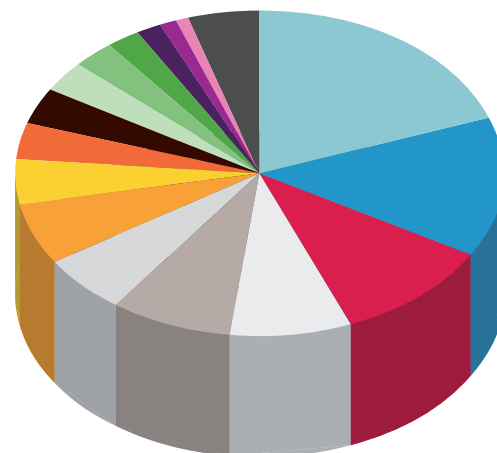

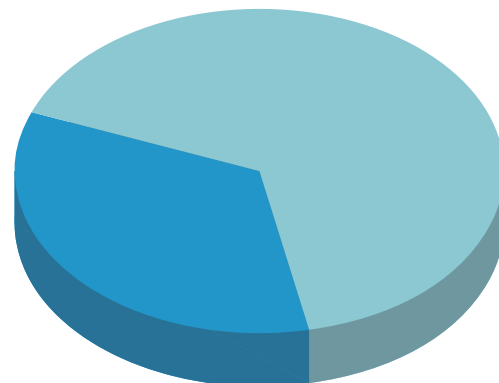

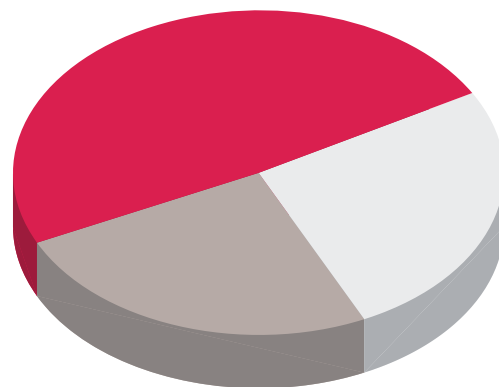



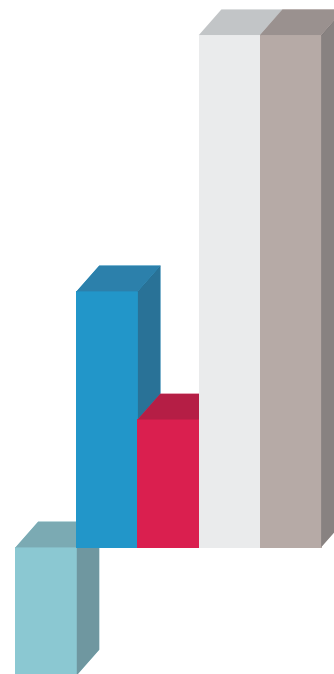

EMU balance in % GDP

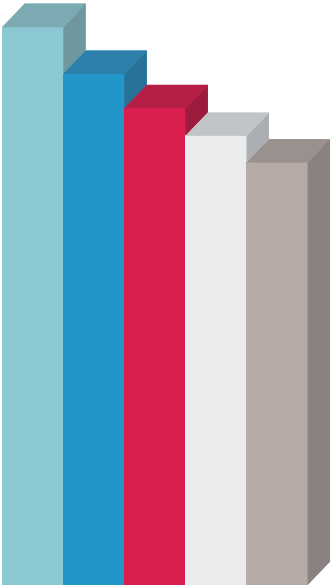

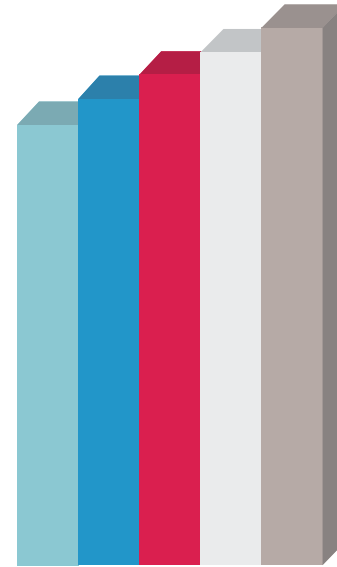


EMU debt in % GDP
